STATEMENT OF FAITH
Victory Bible Christian School

We Believe the Holy Scriptures Teach:

- *that the* Bible in Its original documents is the inspired Word of God. It has been preserved by God for us today, and It is final in Its content, and without error in Its statements.

- *that there* is one God eternally existent and all-powerful who is manifested to us in three persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

- *that the* Lord Jesus Christ is God's only begotten Son, fully God in the flesh, who came and lived a sinless life here on our earth.

- *that He* gave up His divine life willingly as the complete and sacrificial payment for every person's sins, and that He bodily arose again from death after three days.

- *that every* person needs Christ as Savior because they are lost apart from Him.

- *that every* person who chooses of their own free will to believe God's record of His Son, trusting in the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior, is sure to go to Heaven. Their salvation can never be removed, lost, or changed in any way. They are eternally secure because their salvation is by grace through their faith in Jesus Christ, and has been accomplished through the *finished* work of Christ rather than by their own works.

- *that this* trust in Christ bringing one salvation is *not* Biblical saving faith unless it is trust in Christ alone. Christ + baptism, or Christ + obedience, or Christ + surrender do not = Christ *alone*.

- *that*, having trusted in Christ, a believer should partake of believer's baptism, communion, and get involved in living for Christ at a local, Bible-believing and Gospel-preaching church.

- *that it* is the duty of every Christian to preach the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.

- *that* sign gifts were temporary and *fully ceased* when God's written record was complete. These include the charismatic gifts such as speaking in tongues, or the Apostolic gifts such as miraculous healing or raising of the dead. As Acts 2:8 states "*How hear we every man in our own tongue wherein we were born?*"

- *that it* is God's will in the present church age that He be revealed to us through His Word and the convicting and enlightening work of the Holy Spirit who indwells every believer at the moment of their salvation.

- *that the* Lord Jesus Christ will return at any moment to catch His bride, the Church, away.

- *that the* only form of marriage recognized by God is the union of one man to one woman.

Admission Process
Four Year Old Kindergarten Student

Families seeking to enroll students for the upcoming school year should follow the procedure outlined below. As part of our application process, we require several forms to be completed. Some are due with the application, some are due before the admissions interview, and others are due by the beginning of the school year. **Please be sure to follow these guidelines to avoid delays in the processing of your application.**

1. Fill out a "K4 Application for Enrollment". Be sure to fill out all pages completely.
2. **Submit your application and the required documentation; be sure forms are complete and signed.**
 - **Application for Enrollment**
 - **Student's birth certificate** (copy)
 - **Student's Immunization History** (Available from your doctor's office)
3. The **non-refundable registration fee** should accompany the application. The Registration fee for our K4 is \$90.00. Checks should be made payable to VICTORY Bible Baptist Church. Completed forms should be submitted to VICTORY Bible Baptist Church, 10245 Broad River Road, Irmo, SC 29063.
4. The administrative staff will call to confirm that we have received your application if sent by mail. Student applications are reviewed in the order in which they are received and, if approved, are accepted as spaces are available. Families on the waiting list will be called if spaces become available throughout the school year.
5. **An admissions interview will be scheduled only after the required documentation has been received.** Parents and students should attend.
6. After the interview, the school office will notify the family of the student's admittance status. Students should have a physical exam and have the doctor's office complete the Student's Physical Examination and Student's Immunization History by the first day of school.

Victory Bible Christian School admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school.

Dress For 4 Year Old Kindergarten

Girls –

1. Girls wear knee length dresses, jumpers, skorts, or culottes, or culotte-type full shorts. Dress should provide comfort and modesty in play and schoolwork. Dress should not promote pictures, writing, advertising, slogans, cartoon pictures, etc. (These are often intended to convey advertisements or make statements.)
2. Girls wear regular shoes, sandals, or tennis shoes. (No flip-flops, though.) Girls should wear cuff socks, knee socks, or girls' tights with their shoes. (Anklet socks are not appropriate.)
3. Girls' hair adornments and jewelry may not be distracting, faddish in style, or excessive in appearance. Dangling earrings are not allowed at school for educational reasons. Body piercings and tattoos are not acceptable.

Boys -

1. Boys wear elastic waist, pull-up pants. (Please, no elastic legs on these pants.) Pullover shirts with sleeves, with or without buttons or collars, as well as oxford shirts may be worn. However, no transparent shirts, shirts with holes, or thin t-shirts are allowed. Shirts must be worn tucked in. Belts are needed if the pants have belt loops; otherwise they are not required. Clothing with pictures, slogans, or writing is not allowed. Fad clothing is not acceptable.
2. Boys' haircuts should be maintained so that hair is off the eyebrows, above or off the ears, and above the shirt neckline or collar.
3. Boys wear regular shoes or tennis shoes that are kept neat and clean. Socks are also required. (Ankle socks are not appropriate.)
4. Boys may not wear necklaces, bracelets, earrings, fad wrist-wear or other types of jewelry, or body rings or piercings on the nose, tongue, face, etc. No tattoos are allowed.

Parents, please be careful in selecting other items for school also. We have a wholesome, non-advertising policy for all items. For example, no Disney insignia, or other cartoons, or media characters, that are often placed on children's clothing are inappropriate for our VBCS K4 classroom. The school reserves final authority over whether something is acceptable or unacceptable for our educational purposes and standards.

Enrollment Procedure:

- **Fill out application. Check to make sure all information and signatures are complete.**
- **Submit the completed application and a copy of the student's birth certificate to the school office.**
- **When the application and birth certificate have been received, families will receive a phone call from the school office verifying that we have received the materials. (If the application is received in person, the office will not call.)**
- **If the application is received prior to the enrollment period for the following year, it will be placed in a waiting file, dated, in the order received.**
- **Priority enrollment typically begins February 1st for re-enrolling students, siblings and Victory Bible Christian School's alumni families, and members of Victory Bible Baptist Church.**
- **Open Enrollment for new families will typically begin February 15th.**
- **When the enrollment period begins, those applications in the waiting file will be processed and placed in available class spaces.**
- **Families will be notified of acceptance or waiting list status as soon as their application is complete. Families may call to inquire on the status of the application at any time.**

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES

At Victory Bible Christian School (K4), the object of discipline will be to guide a child toward self-control and socially acceptable behavior by treating him or her with love, respect, and consistency. Discipline is setting limits and correcting misbehavior. Discipline is encouraging children, guiding them, helping them feel good about themselves, and teaching them how to think for themselves. At VBCS we will use these forms of guidance:

1. **Redirection** – Move a child to another, more acceptable behavior. *(Instead of jumping down the steps where you might get hurt, let's save our jumping until we are on the playground).*
2. **Consequences** – Allow natural, logical consequences for actions to occur, teaching them that they are responsible for their actions. *Because you wrote on the wall, you will help clean it up.*
3. **Explain Obedience** – Encourage children about the quality of obedience. Explain that obeying is learning to be grown-up and responsible to carryout what you are told in a happy manner.
4. **Limited Choices** – Give children a chance to feel that they have a choice instead of just telling them what to do. Give them a couple of choices not involving the unwanted behavior. Example: *That is too many crayons to take out at one time, but you may choose two to work with for now.*
5. **Problem Solving** – Allow children to come up with solutions to problems that arise. Have them state what the problem is. *I want to kick the ball in class, but my teacher says I can't.*

Have them give as many solutions as they can think of. *I could play ball outside. Maybe I could do a puzzle instead.*
6. **Positive Rules** – State rules in positive terms. *We walk quietly in the hall, we can talk freely at recess.*
7. **Time In** – A child who has made an inappropriate behavior choice will be removed from the activity he/she is participating in and will be required to sit beside the teacher. During this time the teacher talks to him/her about his/her choice and the consequence of his/her choice, helping him/her to understand why that choice is not acceptable and encouraging him/her to come up with acceptable, alternative choices for his/her behavior.
8. **Time Out** – A child who has made an inappropriate behavior choice will be removed from the activity he/she is participating in and required to sit apart from the group within close sight and proximity of the teacher. Before this, the teacher talks to him/her about his/her choice and the consequences of his/her choice, helping him/her to understand why that choice is not acceptable and encouraging him/her to come up with acceptable, alternative choices for his/her behavior.
9. **Parent Report** – Children will receive small color stickers to wear home each day indicating to the parent either a successful or need for improvement day. The children will not be informed of the color code. Green will be completely successful. Blue will be need for improvement. (At times, this code will be varied, using orange for success and yellow for improvement.)
10. **Rewards** – Children will be encouraged through the use of praise for corrected right behavior.
