Annual Fees:

Registration Fee: \$165.00 with each initial application or application for re-enrollment, not to exceed \$285.00 per family (Refundable only in cases where the school cannot place your child.)

Registration Deadline: July 1

\$40.00 late handling fee (\$80.00 maximum) for first-time enrollments after July 1.

Book Fee: K5 - \$195.00

1st-12th - \$245.00 (per child)

(K4 book fees are listed in the K4 brochure.)

Monthly Tuition: Due on the *first day* of each month, August 1 - May 1. (Ten payments)

All fees and charges are due in full and subject to change without notice.

Payment Policies:

Monthly payment schedules are provided to assist parents needing enrollment without lump sum payments. Late fees do apply for all amounts due at any time. Full payment of all tuition or extended care is required, even though payment is allowed on a ten month basis, regardless of the number of days attended or enrolled.



Enrollment and Re-enrollment Policy:

Pending testing and interview, VBCS will enroll students in K4-6th grades whose parents fully support and approve our school's purpose and mission. Please contact Cindy Reese or someone in our school office at 781-6970 for full enrollment information. Students desiring to enroll in our 7th-12th grades must meet at least one of the following requirements: members in good standing for at least 2 years, or successfully promoted from our VBCS elementary grades into VBCS Jr. High. Re-enrollment each year is by invitation only.

School Day:

Our school doors open at 7:55 A.M. (K5-6th) with pick-up required by 3:30 P.M. for all students. Extended care before school begins at 7:05 A.M.; after school care is available until 5:00 P.M. Please see the school office for an application.

Dress Guidelines:

VBCS maintains a dress code and/or required uniforms in keeping with its desire to achieve a Christian testimony and Christian standards in its students.
